

1.1 **Senator Hoffman from the Committee on Human Services, to which was referred**

1.2 **S.F. No. 3364:** A bill for an act relating to human services; appropriating money for
1.3 ALS research and caregiver support programs; amending Laws 2022, chapter 42, section
1.4 2.

1.5 Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill be amended as follows:

1.6 Page 1, line 7, delete the new language and reinstate the stricken language

1.7 Page 2, line 10, strike "2026" and insert "2029"

1.8 Page 2, after line 10, insert:

1.9 "Sec. 2. APPROPRIATION; ALS RESEARCH.

1.10 (a) \$..... in fiscal year 2025 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner
1.11 of the Office of Higher Education for the purposes of providing additional funding for
1.12 amyotrophic lateral sclerosis (ALS) competitive research grants under Laws 2022, chapter
1.13 42, section 2. Not more than \$..... may be used by the commissioner to administer the grant
1.14 program.

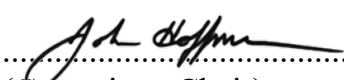
1.15 (b) Until January 15, 2030, the commissioner shall continue to annually submit the report
1.16 required under Laws 2022, chapter 42, section 2.

1.17 (c) This is a onetime appropriation. Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, section 16A.28,
1.18 unencumbered balances under this section do not cancel until June 30, 2029."

1.19 Page 2, line 12, delete "2024" and insert "2025"

1.20 Renumber the sections in sequence

1.21 And when so amended the bill do pass and be re-referred to the Committee on Higher
1.22 Education. Amendments adopted. Report adopted.
